States where corporations must be licensed and appointed in order to receive commissions:

Arkansas, Idaho, Louisiana, Michigan, Montana, Nevada, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Texas, Virginia, Wyoming

States where we appoint the individual agent and we can pay commissions to whomever we want:

Iowa, Kansas, Tennessee, Wisconsin
